- ✓ let parents know about any concerns or problems that affect your child's work or behaviour;
- ✓ contact parents if there is a problem with attendance or punctuality;
- ✓ keep parents informed of progress in subjects at least twice a year;
- ✓ arrange at least one Parents' Consultation Evening each year during which progress can be discussed;
- ✓ keep parents informed about any school activities through regular letters home, newsletters and notices about special events;
- ✓ actively discourage bullying.

- ✓ try not to take my child on holiday during term time;
- ✓ inform school of any changes of address/telephone number.
