What topics are covered during the year?

In year 10 pupils have access to topics from all attainment targets; Number, Algebra, Shape and Space and Data Handling.

What key assessments will take place?

Year 10 have a Winter and Summer examination that consist of a GCSE non calculator paper and calculator paper. The Winter examination takes place just before Christmas and the Summer examination takes place just after Easter.
