Dormston Standards *(also available on website)*

We all support:

- ✓ attitudes and behaviour that support learning;

We do not accept:

- behaviour or language that is demeaning (racism, sexism, bullying or harassment of others or sexual misconduct);

- dangerous or harmful behaviour (violence, bringing harmful implements or banned substances on site).

We expect pupils to:

- ✓ show others respect;
- ✓ follow instructions from all staff;
- ✓ look after the school.

The Classroom Code *(in all learning Areas)*

- ✓ **be silent and ready** for the lesson to begin;
- ✓ **listen to and follow** the teacher's instructions;
- ✓ **respect others**;
- ✓ **work with others safely**;
- ✓ **write homework down** in your diary/planner;
- ✓ **be silent and ready** for the lesson to end.

The Corridor Code *(in main corridor areas)*

- ✓ Keep to the left;

- ✓ Take the shortest route
