## **Activity Week Options**

Your child should also make a courtesy call or visit to their placement before 16 March 2015 to find out what is expected of them. Pupils will be expected to complete a Student Log Book of their experiences which should, once completed, help provide evidence for college references next year.

Those pupils who have not secured a work placement will be expected to attend school as normal during the week. In addition, those pupils who fail to behave appropriately whilst on placement will be required to return to school immediately and will be expected to be in school for the remainder of the week.
